# **AMS-Catholic International University Partnership**

Catholic International University's School of Continuing Education and Lifelong Learning offers over 65 independent study courses (mostly English, with an increasing number of courses in Spanish) along with seven facilitated courses in seminar format (English only). These courses and seminars are excellent for adult faith formation and to meet the AMS catechist certification requirement.

The following is a correlation of the courses/seminars to the <u>14 standards of Forming Disciples for the New Evangelization: Archdiocesan Religion Curriculum Guide</u>. The correlation is designed to assist adults and catechists discern the course that will meet their needs in faith formation to proclaim Christ as missionary disciple in the spirit of the New Evangelization.

Coordinators of Religious Education (CRE) who do not hold a Master's in Theology or related field are encouraged to pursue the Basic Certificate in Catechesis offered by Catholic International University.

You may take either one course or one seminar to meet the AMS requirements through Catholic International.
