### AMS-Catholic Distance University Partnership

Catholic Distance University (<u>CDU</u>) offers 60 independent study courses (mostly English, with a few courses in Spanish) along with a few facilitated courses in seminars style (English only). The courses and seminars are excellent for adult faith formation and to meet the AMS catechist certification requirement. The following is a correlation of the courses/seminars to the 14 standards of the AMS Forming Disciples for the New Evangelization: Archdiocesan Religion Curriculum Guide. The correlation is designed to assist adults and catechists discern the course that will meet their needs in faith formation to proclaim Christ as missionary disciples in the spirit of the New Evangelization.

Coordinators of Religious Education (CRE) who do not hold a Master's in Theology or related field are encouraged to pursue the Certificate in Catechesis offered by CDU.
